2. The value of the scholarship will be Rs. 25,000/- per year paid in 10 installments and the total number of installments will depend on the specified duration of the course concerned.

3. Eligibility Criteria

- i. Students who are in the Academic Years 2011/2012, based on the results of 2011 GCE A/L Examinations.
- ii. Annual Parental income.
(A letter from the employer certifying the salary particulars of the applicant's parents or in the case of unemployed parent a letter or a certificate obtained from the Divisional Secretary on the recommendation of Grama Seva Niladhari of the area of the candidate's permanent residence should be submitted.)
- iii. Performance at GCE A/L Examination.
- iv. Students who are not receiving any financial assistance from university or any other organization by way of Mahapola, Bursary or any other scholarship.

4. Selection will be based on above criteria and the decision of the Board of Commercial Bank Social Responsibility Trust will be the final.

6. Closing date for duly filled applications is **on or before 04th April 2014** and must be forwarded to University Grants Commission through the Dean of the Faculty.
