NALINI MADUGALLE SCHOLARSHIPS SCHEME FOR UNIVERSITY ENTRANTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2015/2016

The University Grants Commission invites applications for the above scholarships from eligible candidates.

- 1. One Scholarship per academic year will be awarded to a deserving student studying for the MBBS Degree awarded by the **Faculty of Medicine**, **University of Peradeniya**.
- 2. The value of the scholarship will be Rs. 25,000/- per year which will be paid in 10 installments.

3. Eligibility Criteria

- i. Students who are in the Academic Year 2015/2016, based on the results of 2015 GCE A/L Examination.
- ii. Student should be a Kandyan Sinhala Buddhist defined as follows:
 - a) A student born from a marriage contracted between a male and female born in anyone of the Kandyan Province, who is governed by Kandyan Law as their personal law.
 - b) A student born from a marriage contracted between a male born in anyone of the Kandyan province, who is governed by Kandyan Law as his personal law and a female not subject to Kandyan law.
 - c) A student born from a marriage contracted in binna between a female born, in anyone of the Kandyan province who is governed by Kandyan law as her personal law and a male not subject to kandyan law.
 - d) If the religion is not stipulate in the Birth Certificate/ School Leaving Certificate, the candidate should provide a letter from the Chief Priest of the nearest Buddhist temple to indicate that the candidate is a Buddhist.

Note:

"Kandyan Factor" in the above eligibility criteria will not be considered if there are no candidates who qualify on the basis of the stipulated criteria.

iii. Annual Parental income.

(A letter from the employer certifying the salary particulars of the applicant's parents or in the case of unemployed parents a letter or a certificate obtained from the Divisional Secretary on the recommendation of Grama Seva Niladhari of the area of the candidate's permanent residence and income should be submitted.)

- iv. Performance at GCE A/L Examination.
- v. Students who are not receiving any financial assistance by way of **Mahapola**, **Bursary or any other scholarship**.
- 4. Selection will be based on above criteria and the decision of the Fund Management Committee will be the final.
- 5. Format of the application is available on UGC web: <u>www.ugc.ac.lk</u>.
- 6. Closing date for duly filled applications is **on or before 10th March 2017** and must be forwarded to University Grants Commission through the Registrar of the University.
