



UNIVERSITY ADMISSIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2015/ 2016 FOR THE

SABARAGAMUWA UNIVERSITY OF SRI LANKA (SUSL)

AND

UNIVERSITY OF SRI JAYEWARDENAPURA (USJP)

Applications are hereby called for the Aptitude Tests held to select students for admission to the following degree programmes. This stream is offered for students who have excelled in sports (others also can apply).

1. B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Sport Sciences & Management (available at SUSL & USJP)

2. B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Physical Education (available only at SUSL)

In order to be eligible for admission to the above mentioned degree programmes, candidates should be qualified for university admission with at least "S" passes for three subjects available in Arts, Commerce, Biological Sciences or Physical Sciences subject streams at the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination held in 2015. (Please refer to the Admission handbook 2015/16, Section 2.2.8.22, Page 80.

Candidates who apply only for the B.Sc. (Special) Degree Programme in Sports Sciences & Management can apply for the Aptitude Test in either university based on their preference. This preference will not have any effect on the university the candidate is selected for. The selection of a university for a given candidate will be based solely on his/her choice as mentioned in the application form in Admission handbook 2015/16.

Candidates who apply only for the B.Sc. (Special) Degree Programme in Physical Education or for both the Physical Education and Sport Sciences & Management Degree Programmes should apply for the Aptitude Test in the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka only.

Above Aptitude Tests will only be conducted in English medium.

Any single candidate can apply for both the above degree programmes by submitting one

application, in doing so they have to apply only SUSL and have to mention it in relevant cage in given application.

Aptitude Test for B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Sport Sciences & Management

Applications for the Aptitude Test should be downloaded from the following websites;

Aptitude Test has two components, a written paper and a practical test that carries 70 marks from the final marks.

- Theoretical knowledge related to the field of Sport Sciences and Management is tested via a one and a half hour (1½ hrs.) objective test. This written test carries Forty (40) marks.
- 2. Practical test carries Thirty (30) marks. The candidate should produce a valid medical certificate obtained from a licensed medical practitioner before starting the practical test (specimen form of the medical certificate can be downloaded from university websites). Practical test components are: 45 m Sprint, 5×10 m Shuttle run, 1000 m Aerobic run, Standing Broad Jump, Push Ups (Nature of the Push Ups test is same for both male and female candidates) and Sit & Reach Test.

Thirty (30) marks out of the total of hundred marks for the Aptitude Test will be allocated for the candidate's achievements in International, National, and Provincial level sports performances. **Original certificates** of the highest sports achievements obtained within the past five years (2010 - 2015) should be bring with photocopies when you come to aptitude test. All sports certificates should be certified by the Principal of the School/Divisional Education Director/Provincial Education Director.

Aptitude Test for B.Sc. (Special) Degree in Physical Education

This Aptitude Test will be conducted only in the SUSL. Applications for the Aptitude Test should be downloaded only from the Sabaragamuwa University website; <u>www.sab.ac.lk</u>.

Aptitude Test has two components, a written paper and a practical test that carries 70 marks from the final marks.

1. Theoretical knowledge related to the field of Physical Education is tested via a one and a

half hour (11/2 h) objective test. This written test carries Forty (40) marks.

2. Practical test carries Thirty (30) marks as explained above.

Thirty (30) marks of the Aptitude Test will be allocated for the candidate's achievements in International, National, and provincial level sports events (please refer the statement above on this regard).

Submission of Application: USJP

Applicants who wish to sit for the Aptitude Test at USJP should submit their applications under registered post to reach "Senior Assistant Registrar, Faculty of Applied Sciences, University of Sri Jayewardenepura, Gangodawila, Nugegoda" on or before 20th May 2016 "Aptitude Test for B.Sc. in SSM" should be mentioned on the top left hand corner of the envelope. Applicants should pay an Aptitude Test fee of Rs 750/= to the Account Number 097-1-001-7-001-4075 (People's Bank) in favor of the University of Sri Jayewardenepura and send the receipt along with the application.

Submission of Application: SUSL

Applicants who wish to sit for the Aptitude Tests at SUSL should submit their applications under registered post to reach "Assistant Registrar, Academic & Students Affairs, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, 70140" on or before 20th May 2016. "Aptitude Test for B.Sc. in SSM" or "Aptitude Test for B.Sc. in PED" or "Aptitude Test for B.Sc. in SSM and PED" should be mentioned on the top left hand corner of the envelope.

Applicants should pay an Aptitude Test fee of Rs. 750/= for each test to the Account Number 0002246976 (Bank of Ceylon) in favour of the Vice Chancellor, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka and send the receipt along with the application.

If any candidate applied for **both degree** (SSM & PED) they should pay **Rs. 1500/=** to the Account Number 0002246976 (Bank of Ceylon) in favour of the Vice Chancellor, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka and send the receipt along with the application.

A complete application should include the following;

- 1. Original bank slip and Aptitude Test fee payment voucher (second copy)
- 2. Photocopies of G.C.E. (A/L) 2015 certificates (certified by the Principal of the School or a Justice of the Peace or Attorney at Law)

- 3. A certified copy of GCE O/L certificates (certified by the Principal of the School or a Justice of the Peace or Attorney at Law)
- 4. A self-addressed envelope $(10\frac{1}{2} \times 22\frac{1}{2} \text{ cm})$ with a stamp of Rs. 35/=.

Duly filled application forms together with all the relevant documents will be accepted by both universities only till **20th May 2016**.

Both the written and practical components of the Aptitude Test will be held on 23rd and 24th June 2016 as follows.
