SCHEME OF RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF LABORATORY ATTENDANT

Your kind attention is invited to the Scheme of Recruitment of the post of Laboratory Attendant specified in the rules made by the Commission in 1986 on Schemes of Recruitment and Procedures for Appointment of staff of the Universities and Higher Educational Institutions, Commission Circular No. 521 of 20.06.1992, and Commission Circular No. 849 of 11.10.2004.

- 2. The Commission at its 1037^{th} and 1040^{th} meetings held on 27.08.2020 and 08.10.2020 following the approved cadres provided with Cadre Review Reports 2017, decided to issue a new Scheme of Recruitment for the post of Laboratory Attendant and to create its promotional grades, as given in **Annex I**.
- 3. In line with that decision, the Commission further decided to absorb the present holders of the post of Laboratory Attendant Lower Grade, Higher Grade and Supra Grade to the posts of Laboratory Attendant Grade III, Grade II and Grade I respectively, with effect from 02.11.2020. However, the absorption procedure shall not take effect for the present holders of the post of Laboratory Attendant Special Grade.
- 4. The absorption of existing employees holding the above posts should be made into the corresponding grade and salary step of the salary scale of U-PL 2 irrespective of the qualifications required for the post to which the absorption is made, as shown in the procedure for absorption of present holders of the post of Laboratory Attendant given in Annex II. Further, there should not be any monitory impact due to the absorption.
- 5. The existing provisions of the Scheme of Recruitment for the post of Laboratory Attendant laid down in the rules made by the Commission in 1986, Commission Circular No. 521 and also the Commission Circular No. 849 shall be rescinded with the implementation of this Circular.
- 6. The Circular will come into effect from 02.11.2020.

Please take action accordingly.

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Procedure for absorption of present holders of the post of Laboratory Attendant

The absorption process in the present holders of the post of Laboratory Attendant will take effect as follows;

With the absorption of respective employees to the post of Laboratory Attendant Grade III, II and Grade I, the number of years of service they spent in the Lower, Higher and Supra Grades of the posts of Laboratory Attendant as the case may be, should also be taken into account when and where necessary for reckoning of number of years of service required to be completed for promotion to the Laboratory Attendant Grade II, I, Special Grade and any other relevant requirement of the University System as the case may be.
