Aptitude Test

Applications are invited for the Aptitude Test from candidates who possess at least the minimum requirements for admission to the Uva Wellassa University (UWU) under section 1.2 of the Handbook on Admission to Undergraduate Courses of the Universities in Sri Lanka for the Academic Year 2017/2018 of the University Grants Commission. Those who apply to the University Grants Commission for admission to the following degree programs of Uva Wellassa University are required to pass the relevant aptitude test in addition to the other requirements.

- · Computer Science and Technology
- · Industrial Information Technology
- · Entrepreneurship and Management
- · Hospitality, Tourism and Events Management

This test consists of a paper to test the aptitude relevant to the course applied.

The candidates are requested to refer clause nos: 2.2.8.15, 2.2.8.16, 2.2.8.18 and 2.2.8.21 of the Handbook of University Grants Commission on Admission to Undergraduate Courses of the Universities in Sri Lanka for the Academic Year 2017/2018 when they apply for the aptitude test of UWU.

Applications for the Aptitude Test should be downloaded from UWU website (www.uwu.ac.lk). Your application for the Aptitude Test should reach the **Senior Assistant Registrar, Examination Division, Uva Wellassa University, Passara Road, Badulla** under registered cover on or before **February 19, 2018**. Indicate "**Aptitude Test - 2017/2018**" on the top left hand corner of the envelope. The application should include the following.

- I. A bank receipt for deposit of Rs. 300/- per Examination Paper paid to any branch of Bank of Ceylon to the credit of Uva Wellassa University Account No:78166821, Bank of Ceylon, Badulla Branch (Please keep a photocopy of deposit slip with you). This fee will not be refunded.
- ii. A photocopy of results sheet of G.C.E (A/L) 2017.
- iii. A photocopy of National Identity Card.

Aptitude Test will be held on **Saturday, March 24, 201**8 and it will be conducted in English Language only. Admission Cards will be sent to the candidates via post.

Candidates are advised **NOT** to send separate applications for each Examination Paper applied. Please send only one application for all Examination Papers applied indicating the examination paper codes in the provided space.

If the paid amount of examination fee is less than the requested number of Examination Papers, your order of preference will be considered to match the paid amount.
